The meeting will be held at the Le Bonheur Auditorium, Main Lobby at the Research Center of Le Bonheur Children's Hospital at 50 North Dunlap Street, Memphis, TN 38105.

Yearly dues is \$25 for faculty, \$15 for postdoctoral fellows, and \$10 for students and includes meeting registration.

Meeting Agenda: The meeting agenda is coming together but not complete at this time. It will be distributed by email and posted on the TPS website when finalized.

Steve A. N. Goldstein, MA, MD, Ph.D. FAAP, Dean of Stritch School of Medicine at Loyola University in Chicago will be the keynote speaker. The title of his talk is "*Ion Channels in Health and Disease: Sumo Emerges from the Nucleus*".

Faculty, postdocs and students will be the featured speakers at the meeting. Posters will be presented throughout the meeting. Student poster presentations will be judged for travel awards to an Experimental Biology Meeting.

Poster titles, authors and affiliations should be sent to Akiah Jones (ajone252@uthsc.edu) by October 26 for inclusion in the final program.

Local Accommodations: The closest hotel to the meeting site is the Doubletree by Hilton (<https://doubletree3.hilton.com/en/index.html>). This hotel has set aside a block of rooms for the meeting at a reduced price (\$117/night + taxes). The Hampton Inn in Memphis, TN (www.hilton.com/Hampton_Inn/Memphis) is also close to the meeting site and offers a \$135/night (+taxes) rate. The Peabody in Memphis, TN (<https://www.peabodymemphis.com/>) is close and offers a \$169/night + taxes rate.

Traveling to Memphis, TN: The airport is approximately 9.5 miles from the UTHSC campus. Rental cars are available at the airport. Check your hotel for available shuttle service and fees.

Memphis is located along Interstate 240, which intersects with Interstate 55, which in turn connects to Interstate 40, the major east-west thoroughfare in Tennessee. Approximate driving distance to major cities are:


